In the second, limited preparation round, SJC A had a decisive win against Hastings Boys' B, while SJC B lost against Hastings Boys' A. Overall, it was a great afternoon of debating.

A few of the Year 9 and Year 10 classes were lucky enough to watch the debates and provided great support to our teams.

2022 INTER-HOUSE CHESS CHAMPIONSHIP

This is the 2nd year that we have run the Inter-House Chess Championship.



Each house presented a contender at each year level, meaning that there were 8 junior contenders and 12 senior contenders. After 3 weeks of chess matches at intervals, lunchtimes, and online, we have finalists.

Round 1 matches gave the two top contenders going to round 2 at each year level. In round 2, we had year 9 and 10 contenders playing each other to arrive at the
