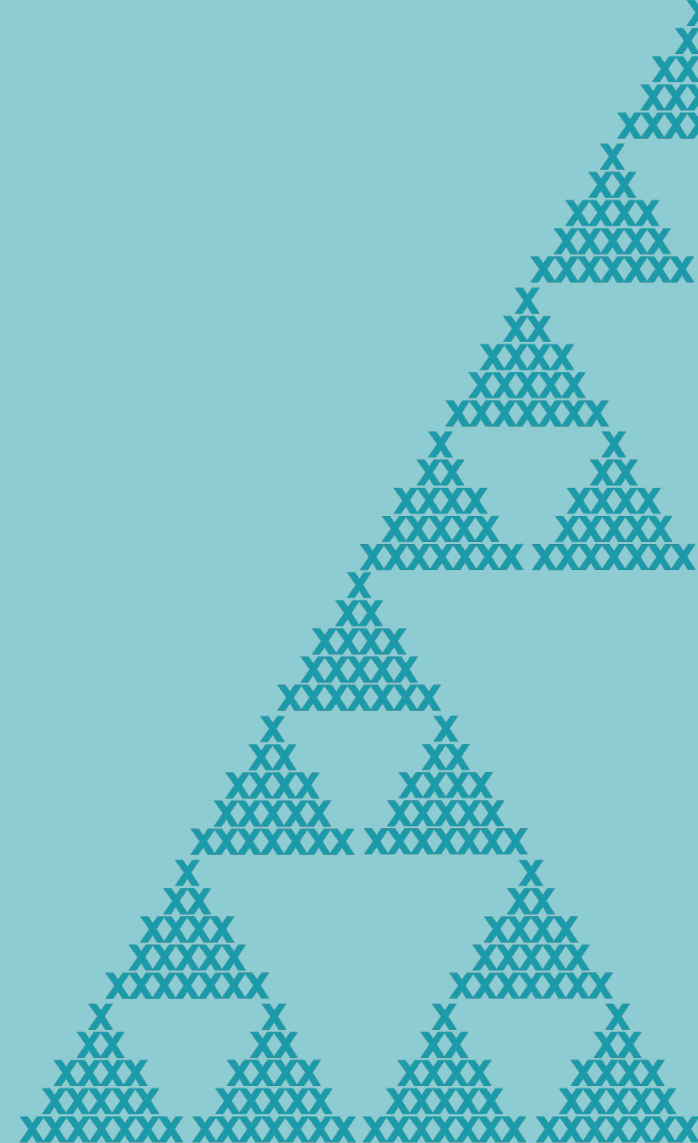

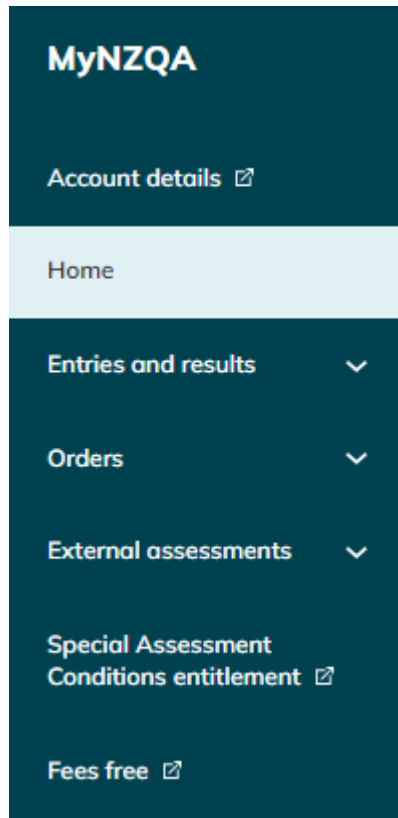
Using your MyNZQA learner account

You can use your MyNZQA learner account to:



- **check** your NCEA entries and results
- **upload** digital submissions for marking
- **request** reviews or reconsiderations
- **order** copies of your certificates
- **print** or request your Record of Achievement
- **update** details like your email address

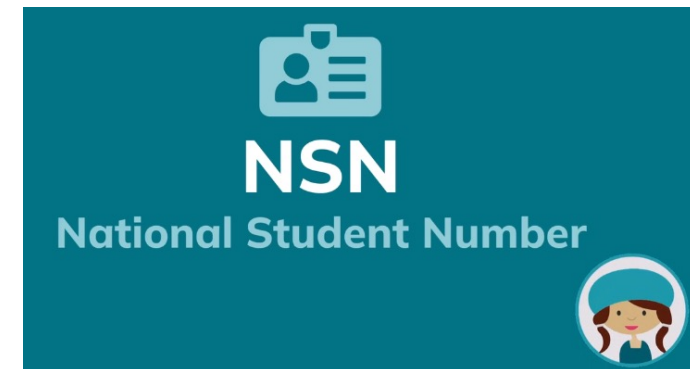


National Student Number (NSN)

If you are creating an account, you will need your NSN to verify your identity (Step 3). This is your personal student number; it will appear on all of your external assessments.

Get your NSN from:

- your school online portal or
- NZQA Contact Centre 0800 697 296 or
- Awhina – NZQA’s chatbot at <https://www2.nzqa.govt.nz/>



Your NSN is **nine** digits long e.g. 123456789. You **don't need to put a zero at the start of your NSN** if using it to login.

Create an account


When you use the learner portal for the first time, you'll be asked to create an account. You'll need your NSN number handy to finish this process.

1 **Create your login details**
Create a username, enter your email address, and set your password.





2 **Verify your email address**
We'll send you an email. Follow the email's instructions to verify your email address.



3 **Verify your identity**
We'll ask for your National Student Number (NSN) to verify your identity.

Step 1 of 3: Create your login details

To get access to your NZQA account, you will need to complete three steps:

Step 1: Create your login details
Step 2: Verify your email address
Step 3: Verify your identity

IMPORTANT: For step 3, you will need your [National Student Number \(NSN\)](#) to verify your identity.

NOTE: Please complete your sign up process within 20 working days from today. After 20 days we will delete the account and you will need to make a new account with a different email account.

Your password needs to have **at least:**

- 7 characters
- one upper case letter (A-Z)
- one lower case letter (a-z)
- one number (0-9)

Use an email address you check often.

You can use a school address but remember to change it to an external email address before you leave school so you can still access your account. Username can be the same as the email address.



Keep your account details up-to-date

- in case NZQA needs to contact you e.g. regarding your results or requests
- so you can access your account after you leave school, change your email to an address external to school

If you need to amend your name or date of birth, you will need to email, fax or post a copy of official verification such as birth certificate, passport, etc. Contact the [Data Management & Learner Records](#) team.

If you are still at school and are updating your address details, please ensure that school also has your updated details.

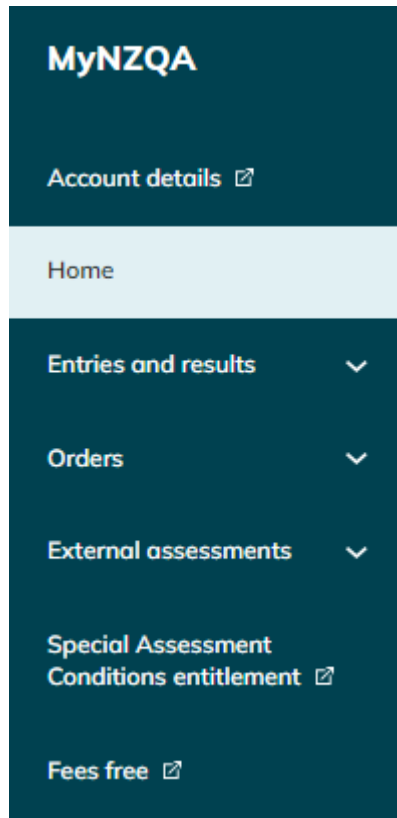

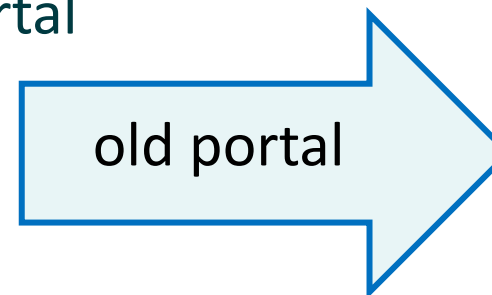
